

Clean Heating Sources in Buildings – insights from Czech Republic

Domestic policy measures: *(what specific regulations have been adopted)*

- *Subsidy programmes for households and public buildings– NGS, NGS 2013, GS, OPEs*
- *Possible combination of subsidies for RES, EE, adaptation measures*
- *Requirements in Energy Management Act and Air Protection Act*

Results and impacts: *(short evaluation)*

- *More than 16 800 individual projects in residential buildings, 480 in public buildings*
- *Investment subsidy of 40 million € / 401 million €*
- *Savings in FEC of 4,52 / 1,05 PJ, avoided GHG emissions 4496 kt/year*

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Lessons learned: *success factors, implementation challenges*

- + *Continuous calls, various levels of support*
- + *Low administrative burden / easy applications / short evaluation periods*
- - *Fragmented subsidy schemes, low awareness*
