











Clean Heating Sources in Buildings
- insights from Czech Republic

Domestic policy measures: (what specific regulations have been adopted)

- Subsidy programmes for households and public buildings NGS, NGS 2013, GS, OPEs
- Possible combination of subsidies for RES, EE, adaptation measures
- Requirements in Energy Management Act and Air Protection Act

Results and impacts: (short evaluation)

- More than 16 800 individual projects in residential buildings, 480 in public buildings
- Investment subsidy of 40 million € / 401 million €
- Savings in FEC of 4,52 / 1,05 PJ, avoided GHG emissions 4496 kt/year

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Lessons learned: success factors, implementation challenges

- + Continuous calls, various levels of support
- + Low administrative burden / easy applications / short evaluation periods
- Fragmented subsidy schemes, low awareness
